If you believe that you are a leader, a person of character and a servant, then I urge you to place your name in nomination for selection to our school's chapter of the National Honor Society.

How can you know if you will make a good candidate? Please consider the following:

- Membership in National Honor Society is NOT based merely on academic attainment. If your life has made a **positive** impact both inside and outside of the WCHS community you probably **are** a candidate.
- If you have maintained a good Community Life Grade, then you probably **are** a candidate.
- If you have focused your activities only on school and not also on your church and community, then you probably **are not** a candidate.
- If you have focused your energies on your church and community, but not on your school, then you probably **are not** a candidate.
- Are you known for pointing out problems and being proactive in bringing about solutions? If so, you probably **are** a candidate.
- Are you known for pointing out problems and dwelling on them or complaining about them, but not moving to make a difference? Then you probably **are not** a candidate.
- Do those who know you speak well of you regarding your work habits and your character? If so, you probably **are** a candidate.
- Are you the kind of person who your parents and teachers know as one person but your friends know as someone else? If so, you probably **are not** a candidate?

Your candidacy will be evaluated based on the following:

- Has your high school career been marked by character, leadership and service? The **Student Activity and Self-Nomination Form** and your *Community Life Grade* will provide the basis for this evaluation.
- Have you left a positive impression with those who have been your teachers over the last four years? A list of candidates will be circulated among administrators and teachers, asking if they would consider each to be a fitting candidate for National Honor Society.
- Do your peers recognize your character, leadership and service? You will be interviewed by current members of the National Honor Society.

If you wish to place yourself in nomination then please take the following step.

Download and print the **Student Activity and Self-Nomination Form**. Mail it to me or put it in my box in the WCHS office before **Monday April 13, 2009**. Receipt of this form places your name on the candidate list!
