Ministry is defined as a regular involvement in a local church or community ministry, under the supervision of an adult, in such a way that the student is using his time, energy and gifts to serve others.

Possible ministries:

Working at a homeless shelter • Free babysitting • Food Banks • Soup Kitchen • Mission trips**
